QUESTION TEACHING METHOD

“to teach is to learn”

Good teaching requires the teacher to ask open ended questions for feedback to evaluate progress, a method attributed to Socrates.

Teaching skills are important for teachers at all levels, as well as parents, especially those interested in home schooling. One of the key teaching methods that is of great importance is using questioning as a learning tool.

This method of using questions to teach and evaluate performance is called the Socratic Method. Based on Socrates, the famous Greek philosopher and teacher, who was a mentor directly or indirectly for both Aristotle and Plato. Socrates taught his students in a manner that was beyond some of the conventions of the time. The method involved questioning. While classically and still today we find many teachers and professors or educational instructors presenting lectures, as far back as Socrates we find questions being used as a key learning tool.

Questioning students not only allows the teacher to evaluate the level of understanding but also provides for feedback, fine tuning the levels of teaching, dealing with misconceptions early, as well as **improving the educational material presented**. Perhaps one of the most key thoughts beyond all the information above is very simple. Teaching is learning. To teach is to learn. Good teachers learn and adapt to their students, and expand or refine their teaching material as they learn about themselves as well.

Students help teachers redefine their own horizons and levels of knowledge. The Socratic Method of teaching raises questions and provides a powerful system that can be useful across the board for so many purposes.

One of the most useful facets of the Socratic Method of questioning is that **it allows for quick evaluation of what a student does and does not know**. Many parents and teachers do use different methods of questioning, however fail to ask appropriate questions or use an inappropriate style. Many fail to ask open ended questions. Instead they assume the answer. For example: "**Susy, you know what circumnavigation means, right?**" Little Susy may nod her head yes and still not understand what Magellan did with his ship in sailing the world. It would be better to ask a more direct question: "**Johnny, what does circumnavigation mean?**" Or you could ask for a practical example: "**Johnny, what does circumnavigation mean, using an example from history?**" (or from something you just studied such as Magellan's explorations around the world).

Many children will not ask what a specific vocabulary word means and will just assume the meaning or remain silent, which can lead to miscommunication or problems later with basic concepts. **The same is true for math concepts and much more.** Failure to provide an adequate number of questions using open ended questions fails to challenge the student and incorrectly assesses their ability. Now here is another thought. Most students want to be challenged. It gives them a sense of positive reward or feedback to answer questions correctly and can also be a motivational tool.

Questions allow the instructor to continually adapt the material and level of the lesson to better meet the students needs. Some students do better with practical examples while others do better with definitions. By questioning students and seeing where their strengths and weaknesses are one can provide better educational material. **In addition some concepts or examples are not effective.** Some questions are too difficult, too confusing, too ambiguous, and if put on a test, do not measure the students' true knowledge but only reflect that the question may be confusing. Fine tuning lessons can be very important.

Finally, **to teach is to learn. This is very important and is the reason why so many teach.** In many cases students shed new light on a subject with their questions, asking something from a different angle than was ever expected. This results in new answers or creative thought and expands everyone's knowledge of the subject.

To teach is to learn. **To find the answers we must ask questions, and those very questions are perhaps one of the most important tools of teaching.**

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES OF QUESTION ANSWER METHOD OF TEACHING?

This method is quite important. Through question, an attempt is made to establish and evaluate the knowledge of students in regard to the subject. This method ensures participation. The teacher should ask question and the student should be encouraged to ask questions.

Advantages of Question-Answer Method

- 1) It can be used in all teaching situations.
- 2) It helps in developing the power of expression of the students.
- 3) It is helpful to ascertain the personal difficulties of the students.
- 4) It provides a check on preparation of assignments.
- 5) It can be used to reflect student's background and attitude.
- 6) It is quite handy to the teacher when no other suitable teaching method is available.

Disadvantages

- 1) It requires a lot of skill on the part of teacher to make a proper use of this method.
- 2) It may sometime mar the atmosphere of the class.
- 3) This method generally is quite embracing for timid students.
- 4) It is time consuming.

What Motivates You?

Peggy Payne, at age 62, is “still stewing” over not being chosen to spend the summer studying at the Governor’s School of North Carolina—in 1965. However, Ms. Payne credits this early rejection with helping her successful writing career. Have you ever had a disappointment or setback that fueled later success? How common do you think it is to respond to failure not with discouragement but a renewed “I’ll show ‘em” spirit?

In the Preoccupations column “How Insults Spur Success,” Ms. Payne describes her own experiences, but also cites others’ examples of defying negative predictions about their abilities:

“It makes such a difference in your life when somebody tells you ‘no’ and you have enough survival instinct,” says Terry Vance, a psychologist in Chapel Hill, N.C. “It spurs you.”

As a college student, she says, she took psychological testing that supposedly indicated that she was too anxious for grad school. She proved those results wrong by getting her doctorate in psychology, and she has practiced ever since.

Her husband, Robert Vance, says he got a “devastating” F on his first philosophy paper at Kenyon College. “I certainly wanted to prove to myself I could do A-caliber work” in that field, he recalls. He landed on the philosophy faculty at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, teaching there for 35 years.

People tell these stories with evident relish. I’m not the only one wrestling some success out of searing insult. When Jeanette Stokes — head of the Resource Center for Women and Ministry in the South, a nonprofit organization—spent a year at Amherst through a college exchange program, she says she told a professor that she was applying for a summer internship. She recalls that this man, an acquaintance, told her that she wouldn’t get it because she wasn’t good enough.

Turns out that she got it. She says: “I have been trying to prove that guy wrong my whole adult life.”
